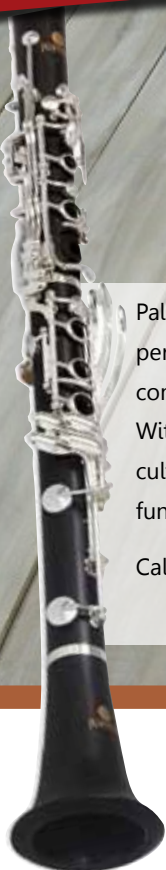

# General Theatre Info

**BOX OFFICE HOURS** - The Box Office, located at 270 W. Center Street, is open Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday 9am to 5pm and one hour before each performance and 45 minutes before films. Closed Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday. We strongly encourage patrons to purchase event tickets in advance when possible. Buying tickets early provides the best selection of seating and no waiting in line. Please note that when the Box Office is open prior to an event, only tickets for that particular show are on sale.

**LOST & FOUND** - The Palace staff takes reasonable steps to locate the owner of lost property but cannot be responsible for lost property or its return. If you believe you have left something behind at an event, please contact the theatre during box office hours (740/383-2101). Found items are kept for three months.

**PURCHASING TICKETS** - The Palace accepts cash, checks, debit cards, MasterCard, VISA, American Express, and Discover. A \$1.00 handling fee per ticket will apply to all purchases. PCAA members may purchase tickets by phone (740) 383-2101 or in person and ticketing fees will be waived. Most tickets are also available 24/7 through the Palace website: [www.marionpalace.org](http://www.marionpalace.org). Online ticketing fees apply (\$4 per ticket).

**REFUND POLICY** - All sales are non-refundable. Patrons may exchange tickets for a future Palace sponsored performance of the same value or pay any additional charges. Tickets must be returned to the Box Office at least 7 days in advance of the event. A \$10 per ticket exchange fee will be assessed for non-PCAA members. PCAA members may exchange free of charge.

**FOOD & BEVERAGES** - Only food and beverages sold at the Palace concession stand or bar may be consumed at the theatre. These items are also permitted in the auditorium.

**SEATING POLICY** - Late arriving patrons may be seated at the rear of the auditorium until intermission or an appropriate break in the performance.

**SPECIAL ASSISTANCE** - The theatre is handicap accessible. If you or your companions require any assistance, simply ask one of our ushers. For those with hearing impairment, please see the House Manager for an assisted listening device. A limited number of devices are available at no fee.

**RECORDING DEVICES** - Please turn off all cell phones and electronic devices. Use of recording devices is a violation of copyright law and is strictly prohibited. Should an artist allow "no flash" photos, it will be posted in the lobby.

**SMOKING** - All interior areas of the Palace and May Pavilion are smoke free (this includes e-cigarettes). Patrons who smoke must do so outside the building at least 15 feet from front doors, windows, and intakes.

**THEATRE ETIQUETTE** - We want everyone who attends a live theatre performance to enjoy his or her time at the Palace. Therefore, we kindly ask patrons to refrain from conversation and use of electronic devices during the performance.

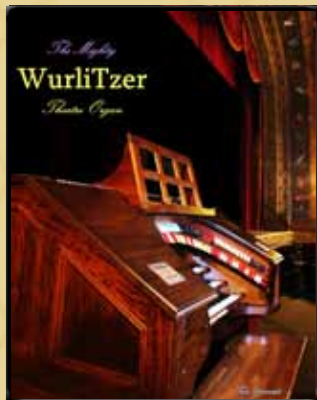
# Organ History Highlights

## FROM PAGE RAINBOW GOLD TO THE MIGHTY WURLITZER

In recent years, the current theatre pipe organ housed at the Palace, the Mighty Wurlitzer built in 1926 and installed in the mid to late seventies, has been our focus. But it all began with an ornate, three-manual Page Rainbow Gold, a treasure for its tone and its beauty.

Banks Kennedy was organist on opening night, August 30, 1928. By the 30s, Regal Spencer played the organ at the Palace and served as inspiration to future Palace organist John Kessler, who as a child sat listening to Spencer on the Page and declared, "Someday I'm going to play that organ." In 1942, Palace manager George Planck called Kessler inquiring if he could still play the organ. And play he did for about six or seven years during the "follow the bouncing ball" sing-a-longs programmed between features. Shortly after, the interest in theatre organ music diminished. John Kessler found a variety of other ways to make music, but in 1957, his love and concern for the Page brought him back to the Palace where his worst fears were realized. The organ was in a rundown state and unplayable. Together with William Cooper, he spent the next five months rebuilding and another month and a half tuning the instrument. In the end, his work did not serve to revive the interest in the organ that he had hoped it would, and not long after, the Page organ was sold.

# a THEATRE *Rich* IN HISTORY....

**1933** Height of the Great Depression and movie attendance has fallen nationwide by 40%.

**1937** Police raid the Palace during Sweepstakes night and take theatre employees into custody for conducting an illegal lottery. Those involved are found not guilty.



**1956** Elvis gyrates on Ed Sullivan show; TV remote control invented

**1970** The Beatles break up; floppy disks are introduced

**1976** The Palace reopened on July 8 with the musical 1776; Steve Jobs launches the Apple I: one of the world's first personal home computers.



**1989** World Wide Web is invented; Berlin Wall falls

**1997** Palace begins using computer generated ticketing system

**1998** The PCAA launches The Arts Palace program offering performing and visual arts classes to children and adults.



**2007** Apple introduces a touchscreen cellphone called the iPhone

**2013** The first Palace Produced Junior musical is staged - Disney's The Little Mermaid, Jr.

**2015** The movie industry discontinues the production of 35mm films. The local community raises funds for the Palace to purchase a Digital Movie Projection System. Movie weekends are back!

**1927** The West Center Street location is purchased for \$500K. Excavation work begins Oct 31.

**1928** August 30 marks the opening of Marion's Palace Theatre to the public. The atmospheric theatre is one of over 160 theatres designed and built by renowned architect John Eberson.

**1936** To increase movie attendance, the Palace introduces a weekly Sweepstakes Night where patrons could win a \$200 cash prize.



**1939** WWII begins; *Wizard of Oz* premieres at movie theatres nationwide.

**1945** WWII ends

**1953** Most American households have a television. By year end, 20 million viewers experience the first full color broadcast.

**1969** Woodstock; Neil Armstrong walks on the moon.

**1975** PCAA purchases the Palace for \$78,000 with the purpose to restore the Palace and operate it for the community. The nonprofit corporation was headed by a group of community supporters who called themselves the Palace Guard.



**1980** The Palace Community Theatre presents stage plays and musicals through the early 90s. Titles include *Annie*, *Cabaret*, *Damn Yankees*, and *Little Shop of Horrors*.

**2000** During this decade, numerous national touring artists perform at the Palace including Tim Conway, Don Knotts, Lee Greenwood, Art Garfunkel, Bob Newhart, The Smothers Brothers, Bill Cosby, and Kenny Rogers.



**2003** The Marion Palace Theatre celebrates 75 years

**2008** The Palace May Pavilion is completed and provides the ideal space for smaller productions and events. Business offices, box office and concession room are relocated.

**2016** The Palace unveils the theatre's \$1.8 million façade restoration and receives the Ohio History Connection's Preservation Award.
