GRETA GROSCH (Playwright)

Since 1989 Greta has worked as a freelance writer and performer across the country. The original "Mavis" in each of the seven *Church Basement Ladies* musicals, Greta has scripted the last 6 installments of the series. Additional writing credits include: *Lemonade For The Lawnboy, The Medora Gospel Brunch, Christmas On The Ranch* and the annual Medora Musical. In her free time Greta is a voice over and commercial artist, travels the country as a motivational speaker and corporate trainer, and is a founding member of The Looney

DENNIS CURLEY (Composer/ Lyricist/Music Director)

Dennis Curley is a native of Syracuse, NY, and a graduate of Northwestern University (Evanston, IL). He has composed music for *Vampires! Horror!*, *Love After Hours*, three shows in the *Church Basement Ladies* series (*A Second Helping, Rise Up, O Men* and *You Smell Barn*), *U Betcha, Psych 101*, and *Pride and Plot of Pointlessness*. Dennis is the arranger of Schoolhouse Rock Live! and Schoolhouse Rock Live Too! (both published by MTI). He has served as musical director for local and national productions of all of the *Church Basement Ladies* shows (Troupe America), *Beautiful Thing* (Theater Latté Da), *A Sea-doo Named Desire* (Brave New Workshop) and *Legendary Ladies of Country* (Table Salt Productions). He recently performed in Theater Latté Da's *Steerage Song*, Troupe America's *Ring of Fire* and *Christmas My Way*, and he serves as improv pianist and music director for The Theater of Public Policy and The Unscripted Minnesota Holiday. Dennis tours the Upper Midwest with Country Roads: Dennis Curley Sings the Music of John Denver, is a co-founder and executive producer of Table Salt Productions (TableSaltProductions.com), and he and his party band The Explainers can be found on the web at DennisCurley.com.

GRAYDON ROYCE (Contributing Writer) has been a theater critic and arts writer for the Star Tribune since 1999. Previously, he was an editor in several different departments at the Star Tribune. He is also a playwright. He co-wrote "Ali," about the boxing champion and two one-acts that were produced in Minneapolis. Royce also created the New Frontier Lutheran Radio Hour, a monthly performance based in a fictitious church. It is performed at Diamond Lake Lutheran Church in Minneapolis.

CURT WOLLAN (Producer/Director)

Curt Wollan (Director) was in residence at the Plymouth Playhouse in Minneapolis since 1979 and with his company Troupe America Inc. since 1988. He has helped create and has directed such memorable hits as *The Lovely Liebowitz Sisters; How To Talk Minnesotan The Musical; Cowboy Christmas* and all seven *Church Basement Ladies* musicals as well as *Nunsense, A Closer Walk With Patsy Cline; I Love you, You're Perfect, Now Change* and *Ring of Fire, The Life and Music of Johnny Cash.* With Troupe America, he has produced and directed over two hundred national tours including *The Odd Couple* with M.A.S.H. stars Jamie Farr and William Christopher, *Same Time, Next Year* with Adrian Zmed and Mackenzie Phillips, *Moon Over Buffalo* starring Gavin MacLeod, and *The Sunshine Boys* starring Dick Van Patten and Frank Gorshin. Curt has had the pleasure of also directing Dolly Parton in her family memoir musical, *My People* and *A Christmas Carol* where Dolly appears as the "Ghost of Christmas Past" in a hologram. His next project with Dolly is a re-telling of the Dicken's classic tale called *Dolly Parton's Smoky Mt Christmas Carol* featuring new music by Dolly. He wishes to dedicate his work on Church Basement Ladies to his mother, Lorraine, whose life as a "Church Basement Lady" served as his inspiration.



WENDY SHORT HAYS (Choreographer and Musical Staging)

Wendy has been working with Troupe America for over thirty years. She created the original choreography for the very first *Church Basement Ladies* and has continued to develop all six versions. Wendy choreographed such favorites as *Nunsense, Pump Boys And Dinettes* and *Diamond Studs* for which she earned the Twin Cities Drama Critic Award for Best Choreography. She was on the writing team for *The Lovely Liebowitz Sisters* and her original choreography for *Pump Boys And Dinettes* has been produced locally, on National tour and for an extended run at the Ryman Auditorium in Nashville. Wendy is the Artistic Director of VISTA Productions which was

chosen to represent Minnesota at the Fringe Festival in Edinburgh, Scotland. Her work has also been seen on the stage of The Medora Musical, Hey City Stage, History Theatre and numerous national tours.

ALAN HANSON (Lighting Designer)

Alan is a lighting designer, technical director, and 3D pre-visualization specialist for theatrical productions and live events. He holds a Masters Degree in Theatrical Lighting Design from the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music and a BFA in Theatre Design/Technology from the University of Montana. Janet Letnes Martin grew up in Hillsboro, ND, where the words "Norwegian and Lutheran" were synonymous. She graduated from Augsburg College in Minneapolis, MN and married Neil Martin, a 100 percent Scandinavian-Lutheran man from Newfolden, MN. Janet started writing books about her Norwegian/rural Lutheran heritage in 1983. She has authored three books and coauthored three books with Allen Todnem, one with her sister, Ilene, one with David W. Cook and nine with her college friend, Suzann Nelson. Janet and Suzann's best-selling book, <u>Growing Up Lutheran</u>, <u>What does this Mean?</u> won the Minnesota Book Award for Humor, and is the inspiration for all six previous *Church Basement Ladies* musical comedies. Her co-authored book, <u>Lemonade for the Lawnboy</u>, is the inspiration for the new musical of the same title. Janet has been a public speaker for over 27 years, entertaining audiences at churches, libraries, civic organizations, etc. She lives in Hastings, MN and is the mother of three daughters, two son-in-laws, five granddaughters and two grandsons.
