### THREE OF THE VOICES THAT DEFINED 90S COUNTRY MUSIC JOIN FORCES


Combined Sammy Kershaw, Aaron Tippin, and Collin Raye have amassed more than 40 Top 10 radio smash hits and sold more than 25 million albums. Don't miss these iconic country artists as they come together on one stage to swap stories and perform their classic songs.

SAMMY KERSHAW has made contributions to more than just the charts. ➤ COLLIN RAYE is nothing if not passionate. His soulful delivery has set country standards in searing ballads such as "Love, Me," "In This Life," "Not That Different" and "If I Were You." Always an energizing showman, he has also blazed through such vivid rockers as "My Kind of Girl," "That's My Story," "I Can Still Feel You" and "I Want You Bad." With 24 top ten records, 16 #1 hits, and having been a 10-time male vocalist of the year nominee (5 CMA and 5 ACM), this truly electrifying performer remains one of the great voices of our time.





Ever since she burst on the scene as a fresh-faced teenager bringing contemporary Christian music to the forefront of American culture, AMY GRANT gained a reputation for creating potent songs that examined life's complexities with an open heart and keen eye.

She has earned six Grammy Awards and numerous Gospel Music Association Dove Awards as well as three multi-platinum albums, six platinum albums, and four gold albums. She has achieved 10 Top 40 pop singles and placed 17 hits on the Top 40 Adult Contemporary chart as well as scoring numerous hits on the contemporary Christian charts.






