



FROM THE DIRECTOR'S CHAIR

Kirk Detweiler, Executive Director

My first memory of coming to the Palace Theatre was a family trip to see the Disney film, "Mary Poppins" when I was 2 ½ years old. I don't remember much but I do remember sitting in the front row and being completely mesmerized, not only with the movie, but with the theatre. Somewhere in my storage unit is a reel-to-reel of me and my sister singing "A Spoonful of Sugar."

The first time I performed on the Palace stage was in 1977 at the age of 15, I was in the orphan chorus of that year's summer musical, "Oliver!" Those two experiences cemented my love for the Palace Theatre. Never in a million years did I think that I would get the chance to work at the Palace, much less be the Executive Director.

When the Covid pandemic hit in 2020, my 35-year career in the cruise industry came to an abrupt halt. Everyone was affected by the pandemic, some lost their lives, some lost their loved ones, and I lost my career and ultimately my home. But the one opportunity Covid provided for me was being available to apply for the job of Executive Director at the Palace.

The past year has been as rewarding as it has been nerve-racking fitting my job experience into what is really a complex job: juggling schedules, budgets, grant-writing, and constant maintenance of a 94-year-old building. Mistakes have been made and lessons learned but I am excited about what our 2022-2023 season has in store for all of us. It is definitely "A Season of New Adventures"!

Enjoy this gem of a theatre that we are so fortunate to call Marion's own!

BOX OFFICE HOURS - The Box Office, located at 270 W. Center St., is open Mon, Tues, Thurs, and Fri 9am to 5pm, one hour before each performance and 45 minutes before films. Closed Weds, Sat, and Sun. We strongly encourage patrons to purchase event tickets in advance when possible. Please note that when the Box Office is open prior to an event, only tickets for that particular show are on sale.

SAFETY GUIDELINES - To improve air quality and promote health, the Palace HVAC system now includes MERV13 rated filters and a UV filtration system.

LOST & FOUND - The Palace staff takes reasonable steps to locate the owner of lost property but cannot be responsible for lost property or its return. If you believe you left something behind at an event, please contact the theatre during box office hours. Found items are kept for three months.

PURCHASING TICKETS - The Palace accepts cash, checks, debit cards, MasterCard, VISA, American Express, and Discover. Patrons may purchase tickets by phone or in person. Most tickets are available online 24/7 through the Palace website. Online ticketing fees apply (\$5 per ticket).

REFUND POLICY - All sales are final. Current PCAA members may exchange, free of charge, tickets for a future Palace sponsored performance of the same value or pay any additional charges. Tickets must be returned to the Box Office at least 7 days in advance of the event. A \$10 per ticket exchange fee will be assessed for non-PCAA members.

FOOD & BEVERAGES - Only food and beverages sold at the Palace concession stand or bar may be consumed at the theatre. These items are permitted in the auditorium.

SEATING POLICY/THEATRE ETIQUETTE - Please refrain from conversation and use of electronic devices during the performance. Late arriving patrons may be seated at the rear of the auditorium until intermission or an appropriate break in the performance.

SPECIAL ASSISTANCE - The theatre is handicap accessible. If you or your companions require any assistance, simply ask one of our ushers. For those with hearing impairment, please see the House Manager for an assisted listening device.

RECORDING DEVICES - Please turn off all cell phones and electronic devices. Use of recording devices is a violation of copyright law and is strictly prohibited.

SMOKING - All interior areas of the Palace and May Pavilion are smoke free (this includes e-cigarettes). Smoking is allowed outside the building at least 15 feet from intakes.
