How often do I need to volunteer?

We ask that volunteers request a minimum of 3 events each quarter. There is no maximum.

Is there any training involved?

In order to maintain a professional standard for this organization, anyone wishing to become a member of the Marion Palace Theatre Volunteers must attend a mandatory orientation. Topics such as dress code, appropriate codes of conduct and policies and procedures will be covered. Volunteer orientations last between 60 and 90 minutes and are offered every quarter.
